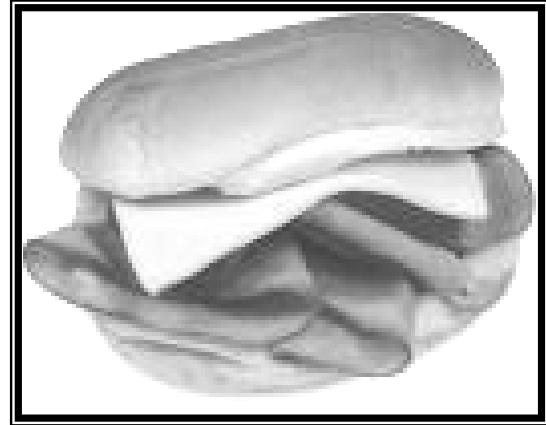
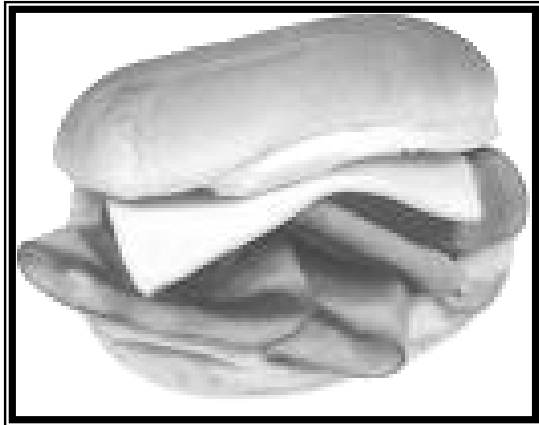

- Make your request in person and then follow it up with a written request that includes the name, address and position of the person receiving the recommendation.
- Send a thank-you to each person that writes a recommendation for you.
